

Filing in Commercial Court Proceedings

Mortgage Recovery List and Winding Up Applications



From 30 September 2019, there will be some changes to the way users file new proceedings in the Commercial Court on RedCrest. These changes will apply to mortgage recovery proceedings and winding-up applications brought under section 459P of the *Corporations Act 2001*.

To assist users with these changes, please see below the new Case Types relating to Commercial Court which will be available on RedCrest from 30 September 2019. Users should use the new Case Type that is relevant to their proceeding. All other filing practices and procedure will continue as normal.
